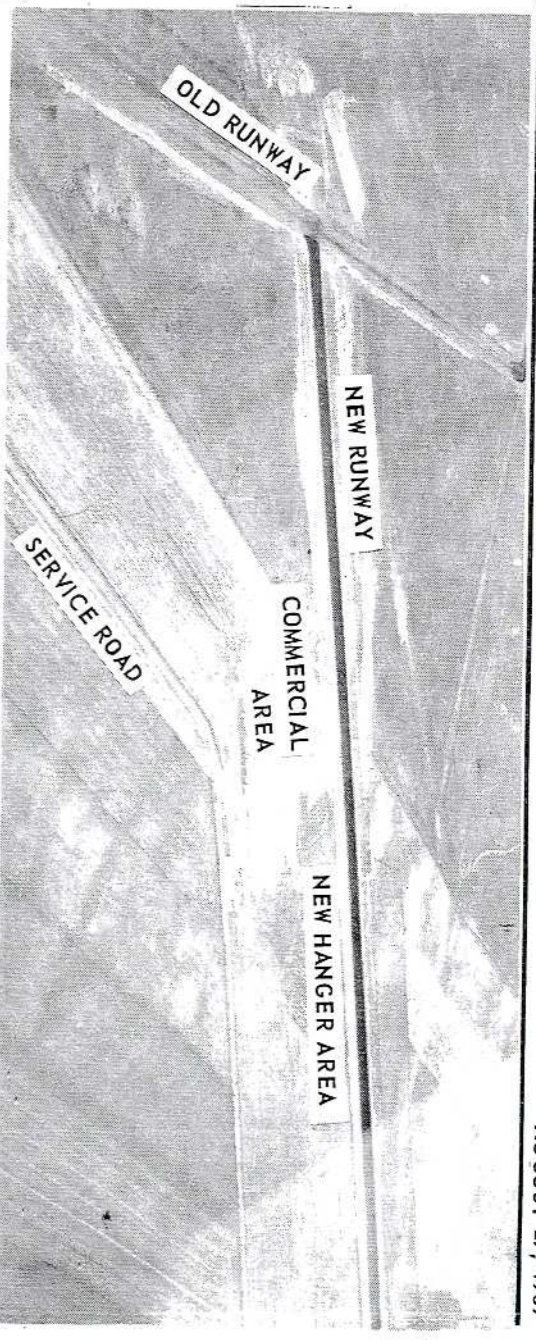
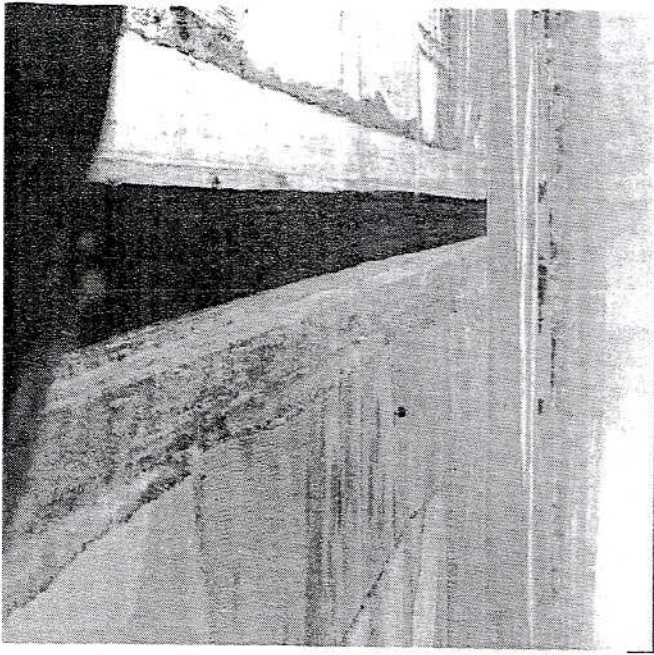


A look at Laurel's airport development
